## Packing List

**Tent, sleeping bags, pads, and all climbing gear** will be provided by our partner, ASCEND.

Everything you bring should be able to fit in a small size of luggage, or a duffel bag AND a small day pack. The luggage or duffel bag will be kept at the campsite while you will carry the day pack to the park and anywhere else you go.

### To Bring: **Bolded items are MUST**

- **Clothes:**
  - The temperature is expected to be 60-90 Fahrenheit
  - Recommend bringing clothes with the quick-dry type of fabrics, nylon, polyester instead of cotton
  - 2-3 pieces of short sleeve & long-sleeve T-shirt, shorts, underwear, socks
  - There will be showers available
- **Small day pack**- for carrying water, lunch, and some gear. A school bag is fine.
- **Large water bottle**
  - Recommend purchasing a [2L hydration bladder](#); This can be put into a day pack and it is very easy to use
  - Or bring 2 [Nalgene water bottle](#)
  - Or purchasing a [Water Backpack](#) if you need a two in one solution
- **Closed-toed shoes**- sneakers are fine
- Notebook & pen to write journal
- Towel
- Pillow
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Flashlight (optional)- A headlamp will be provided for you, but it's always good to have extra light sources
- Camp Chair (optional)
- Snacks (optional)- Some snacks will be provided, but bring extras if you like.
- Camera (optional)
- Cell phone is allowed to bring but may not be allowed to use per team lead's direction

### Not to bring:

- Large knives or other weapons of any kind
- iPad or Laptop
- Any expensive items (we are not responsible for any loss of personal items)
